

## ICE CONSERVATION

### Tuesday – June 15



This is to be done as a Pack or group project. Please abide by the following rules.

**CHALLENGE:** Keep a given piece of ice from melting over the course of the day.

1. **CONTAINER.** Pack/group provides a 3-pound coffee can with lid for the conservation. One can per pack or walking group please. You may tie a piece of bailer twine or rope on to the can to serve as a handle.
2. **INSULATION.** In addition to the coffee can, the pack/group provides its own packing material(s) – what your group has determined will keep the provided ice cube from melting. Be as creative as you can when selecting packing materials. Please steer clear of the following materials to avoid disqualification.
  - commercial insulating container (insulated cooler, cups, etc.)
  - fabric
  - foam
  - frozen gel packs
  - dry ice
  - other ice brought in by your pack
3. **OUTSIDE.** Nothing is allowed on the outside of the can except the bailer twine or rope for the handles. The can may not be put into anything, i.e....a cooler or commercially insulated container. Any materials used to prevent melting must be inside the can.
4. **PARTICIPATION.** Ice will be available for pick-up at the Admin Tent upon pack check-in on Tuesday. To participate, packs **MUST USE** the ice provided so that all packs are trying to prevent pieces of equal size from melting. Plan to do your packaging before the opening flag ceremony.
5. **CARRY IT WITH YOU!** Carry your group's ice container with you wherever you go. Feel free to check it throughout the day, but be aware, that doing so may bring warmth to the ice/container.
6. **SUCCESS OR . . . NOT.** Containers will be opened at closing flag. Recognition **FLOODLES** will be given to all participating groups.
7. **CONSIDERATION.** Please make sure all packaging and materials are disposed of properly.
